Rock Creek Renaissance

The mission of our Renaissance program is to acknowledge the educational achievements and outstanding contributions of the students, staff, and school patrons of the Rock Creek Jr/Sr High School through a process of reinforcement, recognition, and reward. The word "Renaissance" is used simply because of its definition of birth, renovation, refurbishment, and renewal. This program has been developed by Jostens, Inc.

Rock Creek has Renaissance organizations for both the junior high and high school. Programs and events are targeted to each group of students. Renaissance hosts academic assemblies that highlight accomplishments of the student body and generate a good atmosphere about our school.

Our goal is to motivate students academically. Each semester, students will have an opportunity to earn a Renaissance card and the privileges of membership. Three levels of cards are given out based on academics, attendance, and attitude.

Eligibility Requirements for

Earning a Card:

- No D's or F's
- No discipline referrals or detentions
- No unexcused absences

CARD LEVELS & INCENTIVES

BLACK CARD

GPA 3.7 — 4.0

- 5 minute Fridays
- RC merchandise item
- Free admission to RC events (excluding dances)
- Incentives from all other levels

SILVER CARD

GPA 3.0 — 3.69

- Periodic 5 minute Fridays
- RC merchandise item
- 1/2 priced admission to RC events (excluding dances)
- Incentives from white level

WHITE CARD

GPA 2.0 — 2.99

- Assignment Pass (Instructor approval required)
- Bottled water/soda & snack
- Free admission to 1 RC event

MUSTANG RECOGNITION



- **Academic Assemblies**
Periodic themed assemblies that highlight student achievement.
- **Caught Ya Cards**
Staff present these cards to students who are caught doing something above & beyond expected behavior. This incentive is sponsored by Vista/Baskin Robbins.
- **High Five**
Students who raise their GPA by .5 or more in a given semester
- **Stretch**
A student will be recognized from each grade that has raised "stretched" their GPA the most from one semester to the next.
- **Perfect Attendance**
Periodic themed assemblies that highlight student achievement.
- **JH Pail of Pride**
Students award the "pail of pride" to one staff member each month.
- **JH Agenda Drawing**
Weekly drawings are held to recognize students for an organized agenda.
- **JH Friday Rewards**
Students can participate in reward activities during afternoon advisor.
- **Staff Meeting Drawings**
Monthly staff meetings have drawings for random prizes.
