

Rock Creek Booster Club Minutes  
October 10, 2007

The Rock Creek Booster Club convened at 6:00 p.m., October 10, 2007 in the Media Center at Rock Creek High School. The following members were present: Carrie Andrade, Amy Blackwood, Jeff Ebert, April Garetson, Robin Knoblauch, Tamie Redding, Dorothy Schooler and Sue Yenzler.

Sue passed out copies of the monthly Treasurer's report. We have a current balance of \$6,189.79.

April discussed the football meal fundraiser. We served approximately 240 people at the Silver Lake game. Donations towards the meal totaled \$120 and we made \$900.25. We have the following leftover items that will be used for the basketball meal: 3 cases water, 3 cases pop, 180 bags of chips and 30 meat patties. Sue is to contact the office concerning the concessions earnings.

Robin stated that apparel sales are going good. Amy Blackwood sold Rock Creek Apparel at the peewee football games on Saturday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. She had close to \$700 in sales at that event. T-shirts from MGS Graphics and apparel items from GTM are currently on back-order. She is hoping to receive all ordered items in the next week or two. Robin has also placed an order with GTM for lanyards and stocking caps with the Rock Creek logo as cash and carry items.

Jeff Ebert contacted Ricky's Café in Hanover to reserve their catering services for the Activity Banquet (April 14) and Athletic Banquet (April 28). Menu items were discussed and it was decided to continue with the menu from last year's banquets. Sue is to meet with the Office Staff concerning the best way to handle the Silver Booster Club member's 1 free ticket to the banquet of their choice. Jeff will speak with Mr. Rogers concerning the policy of providing tickets for the coaching staff and administration. Ticket prices will remain at \$8 per person.

The next "Booster Salute" drawing will be held during the Senior Night for volleyball on Tuesday, October 16. We will also hold another "Booster Salute" at the Football Senior Night on Thursday, October 25<sup>th</sup>. These drawings will be for Booster Club members (adult members) only and the member must be present to win.

We are scheduled to have the meal for the first basketball game versus Frankfort on November 30. We will serve sloppy joes, chips, dessert and a drink for \$4. Sloppy nachos will also be available. Farmer's State Bank will be serving free ice cream early in the evening. A brainstorming session was held for ways to increase the number of meal participants since the numbers seem lower when serving in the Cafeteria. It was suggested that we sell tickets at the door, have a walking billboard sign and also set up closed circuit TV so meal participants could watch the game from the main gym. Plans will be finalized at the November meeting. April will again be contacting booster members for donations and to work.

Our next meeting will be at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 14, 2007.
